CLEARWATER ICE ARENA invites you to attend our **29th Annual ISI Competition** located in beautiful Clearwater, Florida. It is a short drive to sunny Clearwater Beach! The rink has several locker rooms available for changing. Snacks and beverages can be purchased at our snack bar. Vendors will be available for last minute needs. Our ice surface is 188' x 85'.

ELIGIBILITY

This competition is open to all current ISI members who are competing at their highest test level registered with the ISI on or before May 08, 2015. Members of the USFS are eligible to participate as stated in the ISI-USFS Joint statements of Policy. *USFS members must also be current members of the ISI and must have passed the ISI equivalents of their highest USFS test passed.

Group and Team Events: Ensemble; Family Spotlight; Kaleidoskate Team; Pattern Team; Production Team; Synchronized Teams-Compulsories; Synchronized Teams-Formation/Adv. Formation/Skating; Theater Production Team

All events will be held in compliance with the latest ISI test and competition revisions from the 2014 ISI Handbook. (Rule changes available online at ISI website.) Event Descriptions can be found in the ISI handbook in the Competition Information sections; pages 184-202. Performance Rules and descriptions for Individual and Partner events and Group and Team events; see pages 218 – 301.

DEADLINES

Entry forms must be completed in their entirety and must be accurate. False information can result in disqualification. The skater must have passed the test for his or her level no later than May 08, 2015. Email or Fax preferred for sending entry forms. **All entries must be postmarked no later than May 08, 2015. *Late entries, if accepted, will be charged double the entry fee, absolutely no refunds.***

MUSIC

All music must be on CD and clearly labeled with the skater's name, team name, age, and event. CDs must be submitted to the registration desk at least one hour prior to the skater's event. Please pick up CDs at the registration desk by the end of the current day's events. It is highly recommended that you have a back-up CD. Interpretive and dance music will be provided by Clearwater Ice Arena.

ACCOUNTING REVIEW REQUEST

There are no protests or reviews of judges' sheets in ISI Competition. Once tabulated, the judges' scores are final. The re-tabulation of scores can only be requested by a coach or skating director, who must submit an **"Accounting Review Request"** form and submit \$50.00 to the ISI Competition Director. This process is only a re-addition of scores conducted by the accountant and the Competition Director, whom are the only individuals permitted to review the judges' sheets. Should the re-tabulation result in an adjustment, the \$50.00 will be refunded. The skater affected by the adjustment will be awarded the correct placement; however skaters in the original tabulation will not be denied their original placements. The decision of the Competition director is final.

Selected Maneuvers for 29th Annual ISI Competition

Pre-Alpha	Forward Swizzles / 2-Foot Glide / Backward Wiggles
Alpha	Forward Stroking/ Right over Left Forward Crossovers/ 1-Foot Snowplow Stop
Beta	Backward Stroking / Left over Right Backward Crossovers / Right T-Stop
Gamma	RFO 3-turn/ RFI Mohawk Combo/Hockey Stop
Delta	Right Forward Inside 3-turn / Bunny Hop / Lunge
Freestyle 1	Waltz jump / 2-foot spin / Forward Arabesque
Freestyle 2	Ballet jump / 1-foot spin / 1/2 Lutz jump
Freestyle 3	Salchow jump / Change Foot Spin / Backward Arabesque
Freestyle 4	Flip jump / Sit Spin / Loop jump
Freestyle 5	Camel-sit-upright spin / Axel / Back spin
Freestyle 6	Double Salchow/ Choice spin (Cross-foot/Layback/Sit-Change-Sit)/ Split jump
Freestyle 7	Two Walley jumps / Flying Camel spin / Double Toe Loop jump
Freestyle 8	Double Loop jump/Flying Sit Spin/1 1/4 Flip-1 1/4 Flip-Double Salchow
Freestyle 9	Double Lutz jump/Flying Camel into Jump Sit spin/Axel-Double Loop jump
Freestyle 10	Double Axel-Double Toe Loop jump combination / Death Drop / Three Arabian Cartwheel or Butterfly jumps

**There is no penalty for the quantity of swizzles, wiggles, strokes or crossovers performed in the Pre-Alpha-Beta levels.
Only the quality of these maneuvers is judged.**

Three pre-selected maneuvers are to be performed one time each in any order.

Additional maneuvers such as any jump, spin or gliding maneuver from a test level or any uncaptured move are not allowed.

The maneuvers are to be performed in a program (without music) with a minimum of connecting steps.

Pre-Alpha-FS 4 will be on 1/2 ice
FS 5 and above will be on full ice.

AWARDS

Medals will be presented for first through sixth place.

Team Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place teams.

Individual, partner & group/team entries will each receive 1 participation point PLUS the placement point as follows: 1st place-5 points; 2nd place-4 points; 3rd place-3 points; 4th place-2 points; 5th place-1 point.

Team and group entries (i.e. Production, Synchronized teams, Team Compulsories, Kaleidoskate and Pattern) will each receive 5 participation points PLUS the placement points as follows: : 1st place-25 points; 2nd place-20 points; 3rd place-15 points; 4th place-10 points; 5th place-5 points.

SCHEDULES

A schedule of events will be sent to each participating team (rink) approximately 4 weeks after the closing of entries. It will also be posted on our website, Clearwatericearena.com.

Upon your arrival, be sure to check at the registration desk for any changes.

ENTRY FORMS AND FEES

The entry fee is 55.00 per skater for each single entry and \$10.00 for each additional event. Family entry fee of \$80.00 covers all family members first event; additional events are \$10.00. MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO **CLEARWATER ICE ARENA**.

Entries must be postmarked no later than May 8th, 2015.

LATE ENTRIES, IF ACCEPTED, WILL BE DOUBLED. NO REFUNDS.

PRACTICE TIME

Freestyle ice times are available during the week; please see our website ClearwaterIceArena.com for the Freestyle calendar. In addition, a limited number of practice ice sessions may be offered prior to competition on both days. Skaters coming from out of town will have priority at these sessions. We will send reservation forms to your rink and will post available times on the website.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS

All skaters must register and pick up their Competitor's Packets at the Registration Desk at Clearwater Ice Arena. Only skaters and coaches with credentials preparing for the next event will be allowed in the Competitor's Area. Parents, please leave your skater with the coach at Competitors Area entrance. All competitors should arrive at the rink at least 60 minutes before scheduled time of their events, check in with the ice monitor at the correct time, and then remain in the check-in area. We will do our best to run on time throughout the competition.

NOTES TO COACHES & JUDGES

Each team is required to send 1 judge for every 10 entries on their respective teams. Please complete and return the enclosed "Judge's Inquiry Form" as soon as possible. All judges must be current professional members of the ISI. A judges meeting will be announced 10 days prior to the competition. **Credentials will be given which allows access to competitor's area and hospitality.** Please send a representative from each competing rink with information of coaches' availability to judge.
